



FIS Masters Cup & U.S. Ski & Snowboard Masters Western Region Championships February 8-10, 2019

The 2019 FIS Masters Cup and U.S. Ski & Snowboard Western Region Championships will be held in the beautiful Rocky Mountains in Aspen, Colorado. The event will include SL, GS, and 2xSG races. For those looking for more speed, the event will be immediately followed by U.S. Ski & Snowboard Masters DH training and 2 DH races on February 11-12.

ELIGIBILITY FIS Masters Racers, 30 years and older, are eligible for FIS results/awards.
U.S. racers 30+ must have an active FIS Masters License and U.S. Ski & Snowboard Membership.
All U.S. Ski & Snowboard Masters racers are eligible for Western Region results/awards.
Field size will be limited to the first 200 competitors

FLIGHTS Aspen has a local county airport minutes from the lodging and race venue, the Denver International Airport (DIA) is 220 miles (4 hours drive/shuttle ride) northeast of Aspen, and the Salt Lake City International Airport is 415 miles (6.5 hours drive/shuttle ride) northwest of Aspen.
