

## USSA Alpine Masters 2011 Skier's Edge Eastern Regional Championships Regional Champions Team (Group A/B)

The USSA Alpine Masters Regional Champions team is selected from the competitors in each class with the greatest total of World Cup points from their finishes in all of the three events of the championship. The 2011 Eastern Region Championships were hosted by New England Masters at Okemo Mountain, VT on Mar. 4-6, 2011.

*Due to inclement weather, Sunday's GS race was cancelled. The regional champions were named based on the total points in the 3-event SG-SC-SL scoring.*
