Eligibility note: Competitors must be licensed USSA masters competitors to be eligible for the overall regional class champion award. The standard eligibility rule for the regional champions team that members must be from a Western region division is revised for the special case when the regional championship is held as a joint event with the FIS Masters Cup event hosted in the US and joint awards will be made to the both the top-ranked Eastern and Western division finishers when the class winner is a Eastern division competitor.

In W10, Eastern competitor Anne Nordhoy placed first with 85 points and was named joint regional champion along with runnerup Western division competitor Lilla Gidlow (CN).

In W07, Eastern competitor Margaret Vaughn placed first with 100 points and was named joint regional champion along with Western division competitor Anne Gibson (RM). Second place finisher Michele Van Droogenbroeck (BEL) is not eligible for the Western Region champion award.

In W06 and W05, competitors Maria Luisa Curioni (ITA) and Ester De Marchi (ITA) are not eligible for the Western Region champion award.

In W03, Anne Christiansen (DAN) is not eligible for the Western Region champion award, which went to runnerup Western division competitor Dana Alexandrescu (IM).

There were no ties in the overall combined standings for regional champion in the Group C women's classes at the 2015 Western Region Championships.
