W12 – Grace Oaks of Canada won the combined with 1-1-1 finishes; there were no American finishers eligible to be named to the Spyder US National Masters team.

W05 – tie on 60 points between combined winner Kristin Grebe (CN, 1-3-2) and Gae Orsini (EA, 2-1-3). Both competitors were tied on the best-finish-record tiebreaker criteria (1-2-3). Spyder team selection goes to Kristin Grebe based on the best (lowest) total race points tiebreaker criteria (Grebe 48.48, Orsini 56.31)
