

US Alpine Masters 2020 Phillips 66 Eastern Region Championships Regional Champions Team (Men)

The US Alpine Masters Regional Champions team is selected from the competitors in each class with the greatest total of World Cup points from their finishes in all of the four events of the championship. The 2020 Eastern Region Championships were hosted by New England Masters division at Stratton, VT on Jan. 23-25, 2020.

Eligibility: Competitors must have a current US Ski & Snowboard masters competitor membership to be eligible for the regional class champion awards. Short-term memberships are not eligible for participation in regional or national championships. Racers must start in 3 of the 4 races to be eligible for the regional championship team.

The Sunday GS was terminated after one run due to poor visibility and soft snow and is scored as a 1-run GS race.

There was one tie in the overall combined standings for regional champion in the men's classes at the 2020 Eastern Region Championships in M11. In M04, western region competitor John Beckos (RM) withdrew from eligibility for the eastern region team.

Tiebreaker Notes

Ties between competitors are decided by best result (best result, then next best, until broken; if finish records are equal in all races then race points are used as an additional tiebreaker criteria).

M11 (75-79) – tie between Jim Larsen and Paul Marysko at 75 points. The class champion award goes to Paul Marysko based on best finish record.
