The US Alpine Masters Regional Champions team is selected from the competitors in each class with the greatest total of World Cup points from their finishes in the three events SG1-GS-SL of the championship. The 2021 Eastern Region Championships were hosted by Mid-Atlantic Masters at West Mountain NY on Feb. 12-14, 2021.

Eligibility: Competitors must have a current US Ski & Snowboard masters competitor membership to be eligible for the regional class champion awards. Short-term memberships are not eligible for participation in regional or national championships. Competitors must start in 2 of the 3 races scored for the combined to be eligible for the regional champions team.

There was one tie in the overall combined standings for regional champion in the men's classes at the 2021 Eastern Region Championships.

Tiebreaker Notes

Ties between competitors are decided by best result (best result, then next best, until broken; if finish records are equal in all races then race points are used as an additional tiebreaker criteria).

M06 (50-54) – tie between Andrew Macpherson and Andrew Sorokin at 45 points. M6 champion is Andrew Sorokin based on best finish record tiebreaker rule.
